
We are grateful to the managing committee of the International Academy of Pathology - Indian Division for providing us the opportunity to host this academic programme.

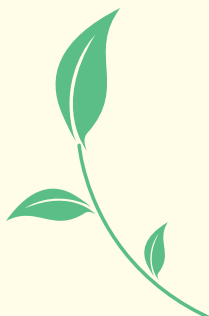
