History

Purnea has a rich history and a glorious past. During Mughal era Purnea was a military outpost, its revenue was mostly spent on protecting its borders against invading tribes from the north and east. Its local governor raised a rebellion against Siraj-ud-Daulah in 1757, after the capture of Calcutta. In 1765, along with the rest of Bengal, the district became a British possession and it was designated as district headquarters a rare distinction in those days. Purnea is famous for its unique basanti durga puja celebrated at local Ramakrishna Mission. Purnea is also famous for the oldest temple of Mata Puran Devi, which is hardly 5 km away from the city center. Some believe Purnia got its name from the presiding deity of the temple. Other believe that many years ago Purnea was Purna-Aranya which stands for "complete jungle", and that's why it has got the name Purnea. 30 kilometer away is historical Sikligarh associated with mythological Prahlad and Hiranyakashyapu. Purnea has contributed immensely to the field of hindi and bengali literature. Many literary giants were born here, at Purnea. To name a few, Satinath Bhadhuri the famous Bengali novelist was born here at Purnea. His works "Jagori" and "Dorai charit manas" are well remembered. His protégé Phanishwar Nath Renu's masterpiece "Maila Anchal" "Panchlite" "Maare gare gulfaam"(adapted as Teesri Kasam, a bollywood classis) are still etched fresh in our memory. As well as Padmnabhushan Sri Balai Chand Mukhopadhyay who wrote under pen name "banaphul" Also born here. Some of his famous works "Trinakhandan" "Kichhuksan" to name a few, are classic in Bengali literature.

How to Reach

Purnea is well connected by roads from all parts of Bihar. Purnia Junction Railway is well connected from New Delhi, Kolkata, also Katihar junction which in just 30 kilometers away from Purnea is well connected from all parts of India and state. Bagdogra Airport is 170 kms away but connected by 4 lane road, thus travellers can reach here without any Difficulties.
