

Dr. Gardner is a board-certified pathologist specializing in dermatopathology and bone/soft tissue sarcoma pathology. He is an Assistant Professor of Pathology and Dermatology at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS) in Little Rock, Arkansas. He is also Program Director of the UAMS dermatopathology fellowship program and Clinical Co-Director of the musculoskeletal/skin block for the UAMS College of Medicine.

In addition to his clinical duties, he is engaged in clinical research and national/international lecturing on the topics of bone and soft tissue tumors and skin disease.

He is also actively involved in social media and speaks to health care professionals locally and nationally on how to use Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram professionally. He currently serves as Chair of the newly created Social Media Subcommittees for both the United States and Canadian Academy of Pathology (USCAP) and the American Society of Dermatopathology (ASDP).
